# 2010 CENSUS of POPULATION and HOUSING

An undertaking of the National Statistics Office

## What is the 2010 Census of Population and Housing?

Census of Population and Housing (CPH) refers to the entire process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing, publishing, and disseminating data about the population and the living quarters in a country. It entails the listing and recording of the characteristics of each individual and each living quarter as of specified time and within a specified territory. It is designed to take an inventory of the total population and housing units in the Philippines and to collect information about their characteristics.

The 2010 CPH is a nationwide undertaking of the National Statistics Office (NSO). It will be the 13<sup>th</sup> census of population and the 6<sup>th</sup> census of housing that will be conducted in the country since the first census was undertaken in 1903.

## What are the objectives of the 2010 CPH?

The 2010 CPH will be conducted to provide government planners, policy makers, and administrators with data on which to base their social and economic development plans and programs.

What are the legal bases of NSO for conducting the 2010 CPH?

- Section 2 of Commonwealth Act No. 591 approved on August 19, 1940, authorizes the Bureau of the Census and Statistics (now the National Statistics Office) to collect by enumeration, sampling or other methods, statistics and other information concerning the population and to conduct, for statistical purposes, investigations and studies of social and economic conditions in the country, among others.
- Batas Pambansa Blg. 72 (BP 72) which was passed into law on June 11, 1980, further accords the NSO the authority to conduct population censuses every ten years beginning in 1980, without prejudice to the undertaking of special censuses on agriculture, industry, commerce, housing, and other sectors as may be approved by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA).
- Executive Order No. 121, otherwise known as the Reorganization Act of the Philippine Statistical System, which was issued on January 30, 1987, declares the NSO as the major statistical agency responsible for generating general purpose statistics and for undertaking such censuses and surveys as may be designated by the National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB).

## What are the basic uses of the statistics that will be derived from the 2010 CPH?

In Government:

- redistricting and apportionment of congressional seats;
- allocation of resources and revenues.
- creation of political and administrative units;
- formulation of policies and plans concerning population; and
- formulation of programs relative to the delivery of basic services for health, education, and housing among others.

In Business and Industry:

- determination of sites for establishing businesses;
- determination of consumer demands for various goods and services; and
- determination of supply of labor for the production of goods and services.

In Research and Academic Institutions:

- conduct of researches on population and other disciplines;
- study of population growth and distribution as basis in preparing projections; and
- serves as sample frame for household-based surveys.

## When is the Census Reference Date?

May 1, 2010 (12.01 a.m.) is the census reference date for the 2010 CPH. This means that all population counts to be recorded shall pertain to this date and time.

## When will the census enumeration start?

Census taking will begin on May 17, 2010 and will last for about 23 days. About 85 thousand census personnel including enumerators (ENs), team supervisors, census area supervisors, and assistant census area supervisors will be mobilized for the nationwide undertaking.

## Who will act as Census Enumerators?

Pursuant to BP 72, public school teachers shall be utilized for the 2010 CPH. To augment the manpower requirements of the census, the NSO shall also hire enumerators (ENs) from the locality. All personnel that will be involved in 2010 CPH shall be provided with proper identification cards duly signed by the NSO Administrator or her authorized representative.

## How will the enumeration be conducted?

Census ENs will gather the data through house-to-house visits and personal interview of the household head or any responsible member of the household. Similarly, institutional population living in Institutional living quarters such as hospitals, sanitarium, penitentiary, military camps, convents, seminaries, and others shall also be visited by ENs.

In special areas wherein personal interview is not possible, the respondent will be asked to accomplish the 2010 CPH questionnaire following specific instructions that will be provided by the ENs as guide.

## What is the assurance of the public that the information given to the census enumerator will not be used for other purposes?

Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 591 guarantees that any information obtained during the enumeration shall be held strictly confidential and must not be communicated to any other person except to bonafide employees of the NSO.

## Is there a penalty for refusing to give information or providing false information to census enumerators?

Section 3 of Commonwealth Act no. 591 provides penalty, upon conviction, to any person who unjustifiably refuses to provide answers in the census questionnaire, or to anybody who knowingly gives false or wrong information.

## When will the 2010 CPH data be made available to the public?

The population count by province, city, municipality, and barangay is targeted to be released before the end of the census year, which is December 31, 2010. The final count shall be considered official for all purposes upon proclamation by the President of the Philippines. Census data will be made available in print and electronic copies.
