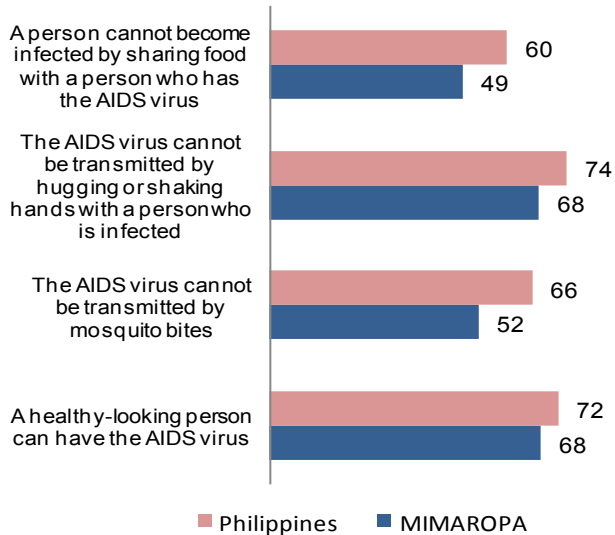

Percent of women 15-49 who say that:

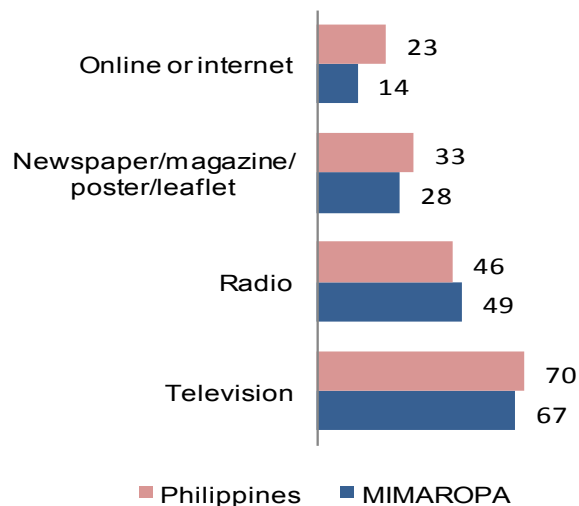

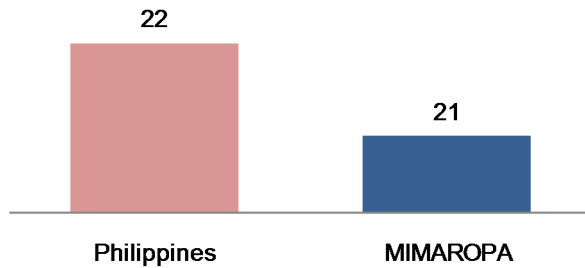

Women's Characteristics: Results from 2013 NDHS

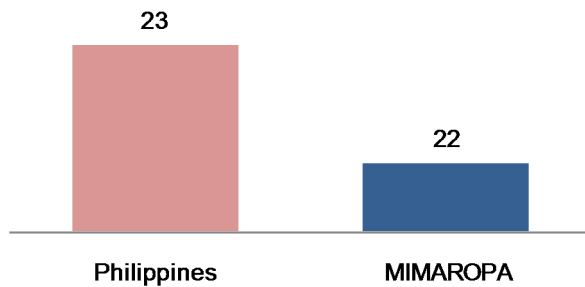
The 2013 Philippines National Demographic and Health Survey (NDHS) provides up-to-date information on population and health situation in the Philippines. The 2013 NDHS is the tenth national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The survey is based on a nationally representative sample households. It provides estimates for rural and urban areas of the country and for each of the 17 regions.

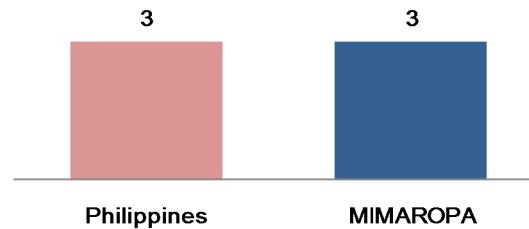
Median Age at First Marriage *Median age at first marriage among women age 25-49 years*



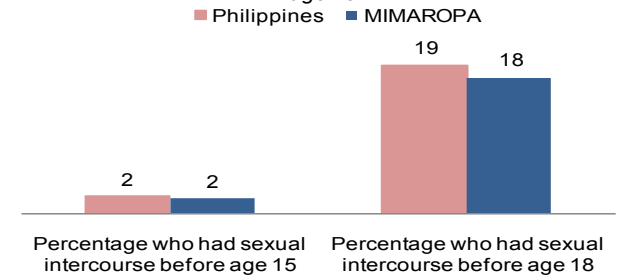
Median Age at First Birth *Median age at first birth among women age 25-49 years*



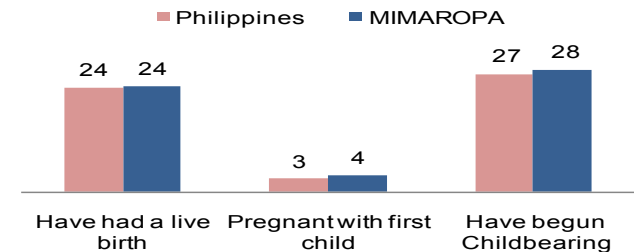
Mean Ideal Number of Children *Mean ideal number of children for all women age 15-49 years*



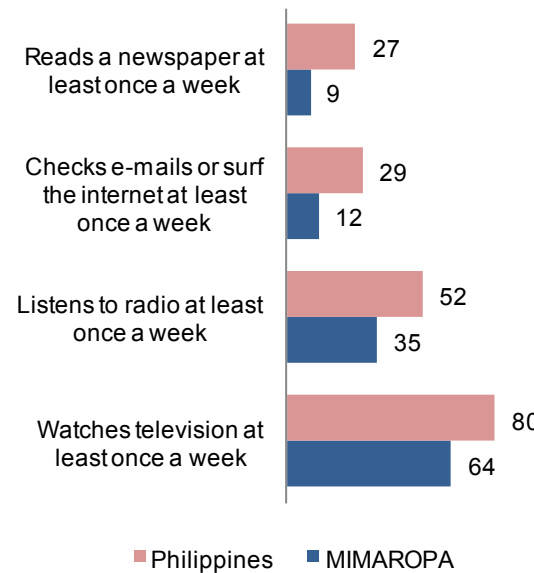
