


Fertility, Family Planning Use, Under-Five Mortality and Maternal and Child Health


The 2013 National Demographic and Health Survey (NDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in the Philippines. It is the tenth demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimates for rural and urban areas of the country and for each of the 17 regions.


Unmet Need for Family Planning
Percentage of currently married women age 15-49 with unmet need for family planning




Perinatal Mortality

Total wanted fertility rate and total fertility rate




Vaccination Coverage
Percent of children age 12-23 months who received specific vaccines at any time before




Place of Delivery
Percent distribution of live births in the five years preceding the survey by place of delivery




Family Planning Use

Deaths per 1,000 live births




Maternal Health Care

Percentage of all children 6-59 months by micronutrient intake



Definition of Terms:

Total Wanted Fertility Rate– represents the level of fertility that theoretically would result if all unwanted births were prevented.

Total Fertility Rate– average number of births per woman.

Unmet Need for Family Planning– refers to fecund women who are not using contraception but who wish to postpone the next birth or stop childbearing altogether.

Perinatal Death– refers to death of a fetus or neonate.

Early Neonatal Mortality– refers to a death of a live-born baby within the first seven days of life.

Late Neonatal Mortality– refers to a death that covers the time after seven days until before 28 days.

Infant Mortality– refers to death of a child less than one year of age.

Under-five Mortality– refers to death of infants and children under the age of five.

The 2013 Philippines National Demographic and Health Survey (NDHS) was conducted by the Philippine Statistics Authority from August through October 2013. Funding for the 2013 Philippines NDHS was from the Government of the Philippines. ICF International provided technical assistance for the survey through the USAID-funded MEASURE DHS program.
